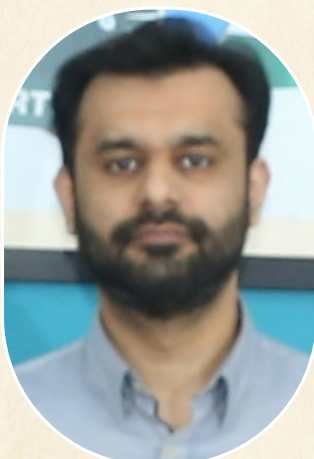

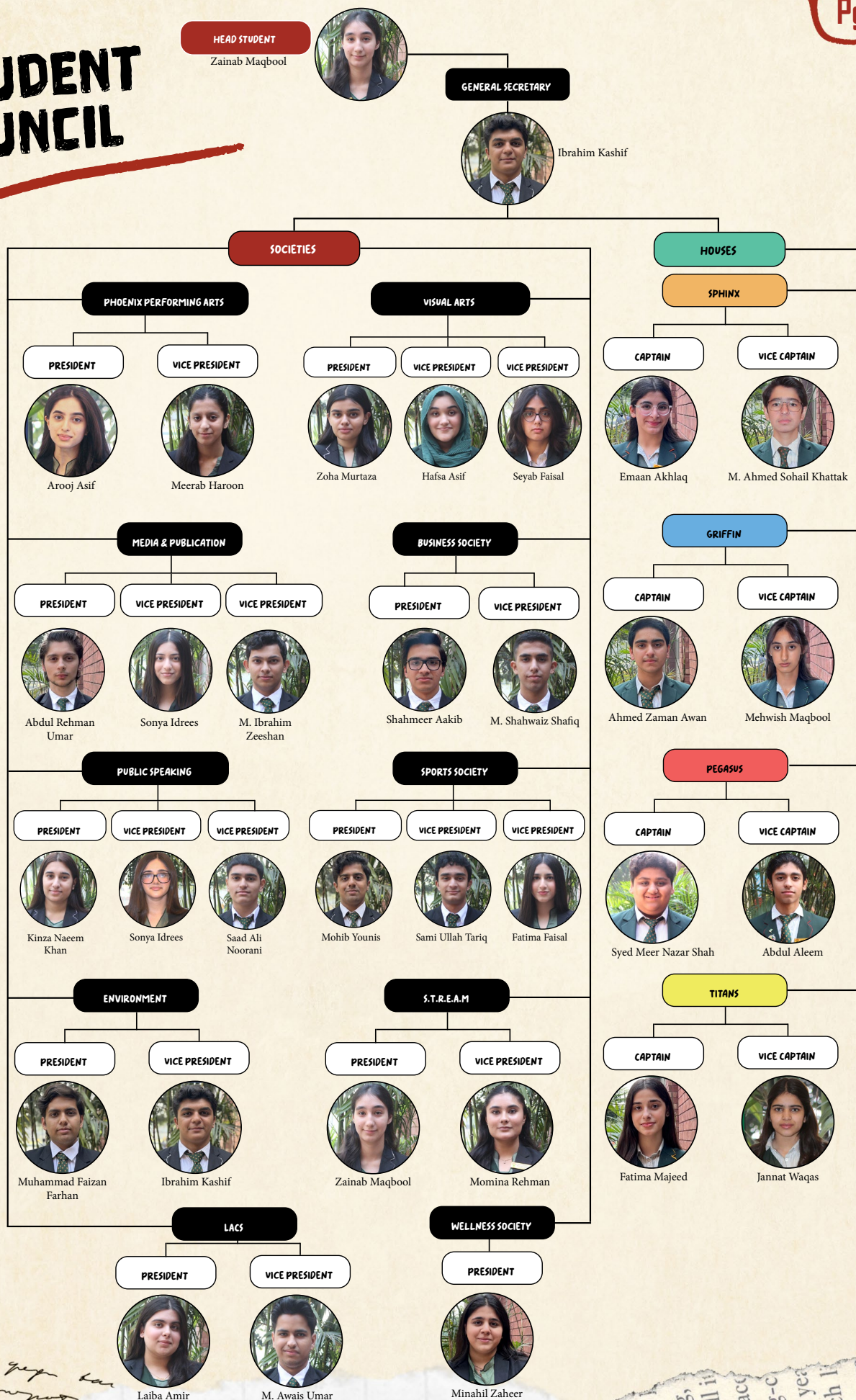
To Mam Hajrah, thank you for being the energy behind every coordination effort. Your jolly spirit made even the most stressful days feel manageable, and your support meant the world to me.
