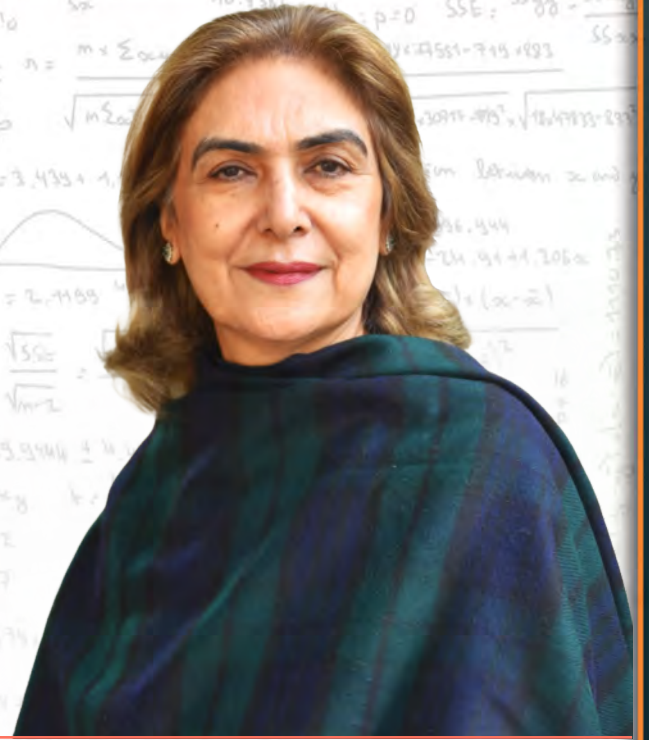

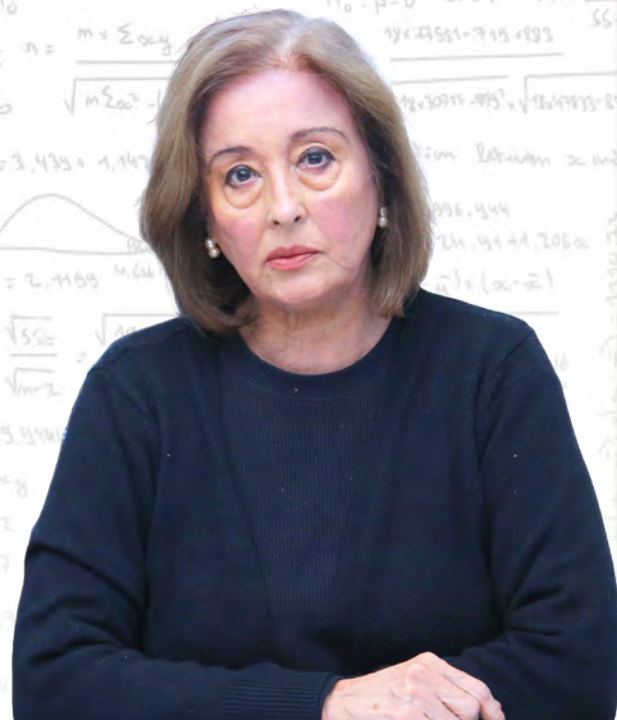

As we close this chapter, I couldn't be prouder of everything we've achieved together. Here's to our students—may you continue to dream big, reach higher, and make us proud.

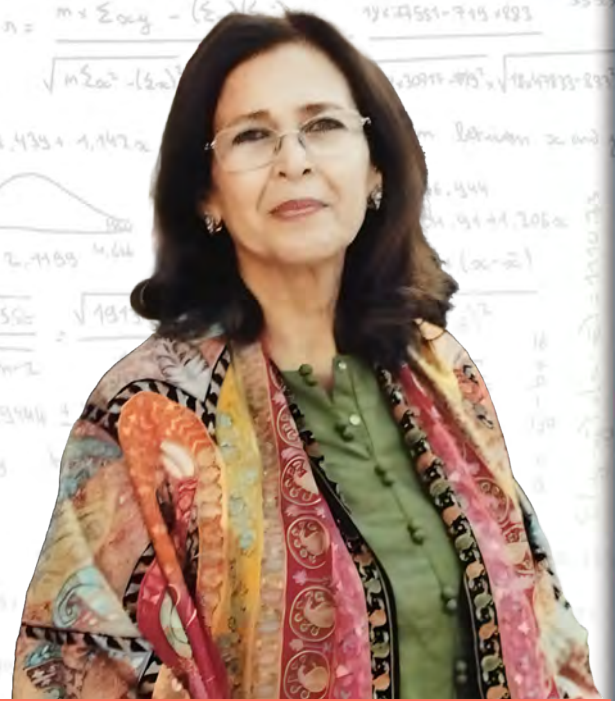
